

FOUNDERS BURSARY AWARDS

Applications and Terms and Conditions

Founders' Bursaries – Awarded in memory of the founders of the BSAP Trust for their foresight in establishing the Trust.

Purpose:

To assist in the education or career advancement of those awarded including apprenticeships

Eligibility:

Members of the United Kingdom Branch of the BSAP regimental Association or Family Member being spouse, child or grandchild and dependents of Members.

The Bursary:

An annual amount of £10,000 shall be set aside for the award of a bursary or bursaries in each calendar year commencing on the 1st January 2023. Any part of the amount allocated which is not awarded shall be returned to general trust funds and shall not accumulate with the following calendar year's award.

Bursary Applicants must supply full details motivating their applications including proof of course and how the course will enhance the applicant's job and general life prospects.

Determination of Awards

Applications for an award shall be considered annually by a Panel consisting of one of the current Trustees, the UK Branch President and the Patron of the Trust whose decisions will be final.

Exclusion

The Trustees and the Family Members being spouse, child or grandchild and dependents of Trustees, the UK Branch President and the Patron of the Trust are not eligible for the award of Bursaries under this Bursary Scheme.
